In the course, students will acquire the Japanese language skills needed at the college level. The students will also learn about the Japanese culture and society. The duration of the course is one year.

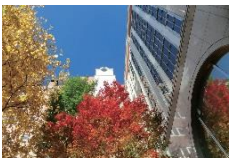
After the completion of the course, they are expected to obtain Japanese Language Proficiency Test grade N1 or N2, and move on to our university to learn specific knowledge and skills.
